Hochschule der Medien (Stuttgart Media University) covers a broad spectrum of media expertise: from printed media to electronic media, from design to business administration, from audiovisual media to advertising.

Exchange students coming to Hochschule der Medien are able to choose from a variety of English-taught Minor Programs. Each one of those Minors is a one semester long set program. Most Minors run every semester, and normally consist of 30 ECTS credits. Some Minors might require specific academic or technical skills.

Furthermore, exchange students will be provided with housing options in dormitories near or on campus and the university has a Buddy Program. That way, every student has a personal contact person who will assist them with settling in and make them feel at home in Stuttgart in no time.
